- 1. What's the difference between weak and strong severity (14, 23). Although one could stop after weak severity, the severe tester accepts strong severity as well. Why?¹
- 2. Explain the Likelihood Principle in contrast to Error statistical Principles. Why does Cox say that optional stopping violates the Weak Repeated Sampling principle? Further: What's your *current* intuition about this highly controversial issue? Why?
